## Background

North Bay-Mattawa Source Protection Committee (SPC) is mandated to reduce risk to five local municipal drinking water sources: Callander, Mattawa, North Bay, Powassan, and South River. The SPC achieves this through implementation of an effective, practical, locally developed, and provincially approved Source Protection Plan.

Membership of the SPC includes nine (9) locally appointed members: 3 members represent municipalities; 3 members represent the economic sector; and 3 members represent other, general interests of the public. Other appointed Members include: One member may be appointed to reflect the interests of Nipissing First Nation; the SPC Chair is appointed by the Minister of Environment, Conservation and Parks; and Liaisons are appointed by the North Bay-Parry Sound District Health Unit and the Ontario Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (non-voting members).
